ORDINANCE NO. 94-05

AN ORDINANCE AFFECTING THE USE OF LAND IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON THE PERMITTING, ESTABLISHMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF TICKET BOOTHS IN THE TOURISM DISTRICT FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED SIX MONTHS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") is concerned with the proliferation of ticket booths in the Tourism District;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to adopt an ordinance setting forth standards, criteria and requirements for the permitting, establishment and construction of new ticket booths in the Tourism District;

WHEREAS, there is insufficient information and data available at this time to adopt such an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, a moratorium is warranted so that information and data can be gathered and compiled in order to prepare and consider adoption of such an ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Moratorium. For a period not to exceed six (6) months from the effective date of this ordinance, or for the period it takes to adopt an ordinance setting forth standards, criteria and requirements for the permitting, establishment, and construction of ticket booths in the Tourism District, whichever period is shorter, no ticket booths may be permitted, established or constructed in the Tourism District as defined by Section 38-1 of the Orange County Code.

Section 2. "Ticket Booth" Defined. For purposes of this ordinance, the term "ticket booth" means a booth, kiosk, stand, or similar structure situated outdoors or affixed to the exterior of another structure at which tickets, coupons, merchandise, food, timeshares, and/or real estate are marketed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect pursuant to general law.
