

MEETING IN THE SUNSHINE MINUTES
November 4, 2005

MEETING OPENED

County Mayor Richard T. Crotty and City of Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer met in the City of Orlando Council Chambers on the Second Floor of City Hall, 400 South Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida, on Friday, November 4, 2005, at 9:36 a.m., for discussion on public facilities regarding arts, education, sports, and entertainment programs.

For the record, City Mayor Dyer stated that notification signs were posted at the originally scheduled meeting place, the City Mayor's Cabinet Room, Orlando City Hall, 3rd Floor, 400 South Orange Avenue, Orlando, Florida, that the meeting was relocated to the City of Orlando Council Chambers.

City Mayor Dyer noted County Mayor Crotty's and his public service backgrounds, their community involvement, and working relationships.

County Mayor Crotty presented a report on Orange County development and enhancing facilities.

City Mayor Dyer announced the creation of an executive management team to oversee the regional upgrade of community facilities consisting of two appointees each from the City of Orlando and Orange County. City Mayor Dyer appointed Dykes Everett, the City Attorney; and Jay Berlinsky, a consultant for the City of Orlando, as the City's representatives. County Mayor Crotty appointed Ajit Lalchandani, the County Administrator; and Tom Drage, the County Attorney, as the County's representatives.
