

### MEETING OPENED

Upon a motion by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Fernandez, and carried with County Mayor Crotty and Commissioners Sindler, Fernandez, Stewart, Segal, and Hartage voting AYE by voice vote; Commissioner Jacobs voting NO by voice vote; the Board adopted Resolution 2006-M-65 setting the countywide millage rate.

A motion by Commissioner Hartage to reallocate \$25,000 in funding from reserves to ACORN Housing for Earned Income Tax Credit died for the lack of a second.

Staff announced the budget information.

Upon a motion by County Mayor Crotty, seconded by Commissioner Fernandez, and carried with County Mayor Crotty and Commissioners Fernandez, Stewart, Segal and Hartage voting AYE by voice vote; Commissioners Jacobs and Sindler voting NO by voice vote; the Board adopted Resolution 2006-M-66 adopting the County budget.
