### JOINT TEA-21 GRANT APPLICATION CADY WAY/CROSS SEMINOLE TRAILS

WHEREAS, Orange County supports efforts to create a system of non-motorized multi-use trails in Central Florida; and

WHEREAS, Orange County desires to develop Cady Way Trail Phase 2 as a part of this regional system; and

WHEREAS, Orange County recognizes the need to cooperate with other counties and municipalities to accomplish this goal; and

WHEREAS, Orange County desires to submit this project for funding under the *Transportation Efficiency Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century* (TEA-21).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Orange County Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to develop and submit a joint TEA-21 application with Seminole County and the municipalities of Winter Park, Oviedo, and Winter Springs for the Cady Way Trail Phase 2/Cross Seminole Trail Phase 2 project.

Section 2. Orange County Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to seek the support of other counties, municipalities, agencies, advisory boards or organizations for the project.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
