# RESOLUTION

**ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

## **ESTABLISHING THE GREEN PLACE AD HOC ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the County has established a Green Place Initiative for the purpose of acquiring and protecting environmentally sensitive lands within Orange County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners desires to appoint a Green Place Ad Hoc Advisory Committee to advise as to the selection of said environmentally sensitive lands.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby creates the Green Place Ad Hoc Advisory Committee (the "Advisory Committee"). The purpose of the Advisory Committee is to advise the Environmental Protection Division Manager as to the selection of environmentally sensitive lands.

Section 2. The Advisory Committee shall have eleven members. Membership of the Advisory Committee shall be as follows:

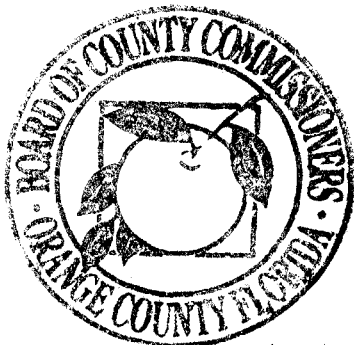
- (1) One representative from each of the following organizations: St. Johns River Water Management District, South Florida Water Management District, Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Orange County Environmental Protection Division, The Nature Conservancy, and the Florida Trust for Public Lands. Each representative shall be selected by the chief executive of the respective entity; and

- (2) Four citizen representatives who are actively involved in local environmental issues, appointed by the County Chairman; and
- (3) One representative of academia having significant experience in the field of environmental issues, appointed by the County Chairman.

Section 3. The members of the Advisory Committee shall serve one 18-month term.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption. The Green Place Ad Hoc Advisory Committee shall be dissolved upon expiration of the 18-month terms of the Advisory Committee members.
