Orange County's Acceptance of the Continuity of Operations Plans and Annex and the Terrorism Incident Response Annex

Resolution No. 2004 - M-44

WHEREAS, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes and amendments, assigns to the Board of County Commissioners, responsibility for the development of Continuity of Operations Plans for the following disciplines: Public Works, Emergency Medical Services, Communications, Fire Rescue, Law Enforcement and Emergency Management Plan to include the Terrorism Incident Response Annex and Continuity of Operations Annex; and

WHEREAS, being prepared for disasters, means being ready to respond promptly as danger threatens, to save life and protect property, and to provide relief from suffering and privation; and

WHEREAS, local services may be overburdened or inadequate, and local government will have to operate effectively in different ways than in normal times to provide timely relief and minimize hardships in the event of natural and technological disasters in Orange County; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 9G-6, Florida Administrative Code, requires each County to develop a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan along with accompanying annexes and additional plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Orange County Continuity of Operations and Annex and the Terrorism Incident Response Annex be hereby adopted.
