RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ADOPTING ORANGE COUNTY RECLAIMED WATER RATES FOR THE COMMERCIAL CITRUS GROWERS

Resolution No. 2005-M-29

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners establishes and collects rates, fees and charges for its Wastewater System pursuant to its home rule powers granted to the County by the Florida Constitution, the Orange County Charter, Chapter 125 of Florida Statutes and any other applicable statutory authority.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now desires to establish and adopt a Reclaimed Water Rate for the Commercial Citrus Growers as authorized by Section 37-659, Orange County Code.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Adoption of a Reclaimed Water Rate for the Commercial Citrus Growers.

The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts an Orange County Reclaimed Water Rate for the Commercial Citrus Growers attached hereto and incorporated in this Resolution as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. Implementation of Reclaimed Water Rate.

(a) Implementation of the Reclaimed Water Rate will commence for each Commercial Citrus Grower upon the approval by the Board of County Commissioners of this Resolution.

(b) For those Commercial Citrus Growers receiving reclaimed water under written contract, the contract shall prevail for the contract term, if and to the extent, there is any inconsistency between the provisions of this resolution and its exhibits and the provisions of the contract.

Section 3. Meter Fees and Meter Installation Fees; Time of Payment. As of the

effective date of this Resolution, all new Commercial Citrus Growers shall pay the adopted applicable meter fees and meter installation fees prior to connection. Said fees shall be determined pursuant to the Water Meter Charge Schedule, included in the Water Rate Resolution attached hereto for your information.

Section 4. Severability and Provisions. If any provisions of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared severable.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect January 1, 2006.

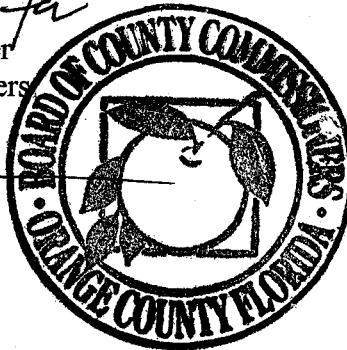

Note: Following satisfactory completion of the water supply and distribution system, and upon receipt of the applicable meter/connection fee, the Orange County Utilities Department (OCUD) shall furnish and install the necessary fittings, meter, and meter box at the property line. The owner or developer of the property desiring service shall bear the expense of the service lateral pipe of the required size, from and including its connection with a corporation stop at the water distribution main in the right-of-way to and including a curb stop at the property line. Service piping from the meter to the building is to be installed by and/or at the expense of the property owner or builder.

FOOTNOTES

- (1) The OCUD shall determine the appropriate meter size for use by all its customers.
- (2) Does not include any cost associated with construction of a water lateral from the meter to the water main providing service; in the majority of cases, the developer constructs the lateral. In situations where the OCUD would be responsible for the lateral, the cost of the lateral would be charged to the customer on a time, materials, and pro rata overhead cost basis.
