**A RESOLUTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS IN SUPPORT OF LYNX SERVICES ON ALAFAYA
CIRCULATOR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, many residents of Orange County use the Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority (hereinafter "LYNX") services; and

WHEREAS, daily commutes in Orange County by residents using personal motor vehicles contribute to the congestion of an already overburdened roadway system; and

WHEREAS, LYNX is considering the possibility of developing an Alafaya Circulator service in Orange County on Alafaya Trail between UCF and Waterford Lakes Town Center; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners, contingent upon revenue availability, supports provision of local funds to match the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Service Development Grant funds awarded to provide service on the LYNX Alafaya Circulator for fiscal year 2007.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

Section 1. The Orange County Board of County Commissioners supports the LYNX Alafaya Circulator service in Orange County and urges LYNX to pursue said service;

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final adoption by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners.

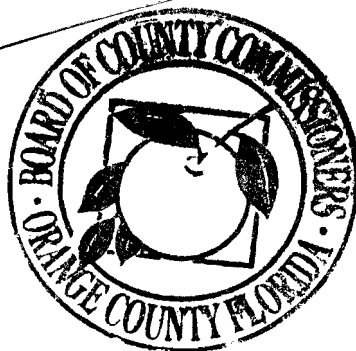
