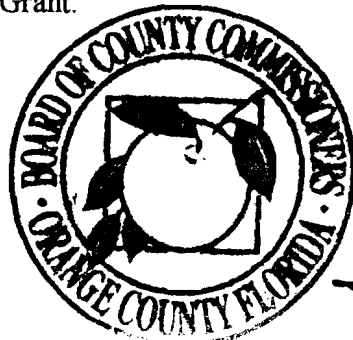
WHEREAS, the Orange County Sheriff's Office has applied for a grant from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, in the amount of \$112,000, for the purpose of enhancing boater safety; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant is designed to enhance boater safety by: 1) providing an improved venue with which to conduct voluntary boater education to include safe boating practices, proper utilization of safety equipment, vessel navigation, seamanship skills, and legal requirements for vessel operation; and 2) procuring a vessel simulator, monitoring screens, and promotional media to fuel interest and support in achieving the project's goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, said grant provides that "the governing body must adopt a resolution certifying that the Project Manager of said grant has the authority to apply for and administer the grant on behalf of the Applicant"; and

WHEREAS, Sheriff Kevin Beary, as the Applicant, has named Master Deputy Scott Ferguson as the Project Manager for said grant project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County Florida, hereby acknowledge that Sheriff Kevin Beary has the authority to apply for and administer, through his designee, the funding received through the Florida Boating Improvement Program Boating Education Grant.
