13 **Resolution No. 2010-M-42**

14 WHEREAS, on April 8, 2008, in response to health and safety concerns related to
15 discoveries of World War II-era unexploded ordnance in the approximately 12,500-acre area
16 known as the Pinecastle Jeep Range, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners
17 adopted Resolution No. 2008-M-11, "Resolution of the Orange County Board of County
18 Commissioners regarding Enhanced Requirements for Permits and Approvals for Certain
19 Development Activity within the Pinecastle Jeep Range" ("The PJR Resolution"); and

20 WHEREAS, the PJR Resolution contemplated that at approximately the same time, the
21 United States Army Corps of Engineers ("ACoE") was commencing an investigative study (the
22 "Feasibility Study") to determine the ongoing risks associated with unexploded ordnance and
23 munitions constituents in the soil and water of the Pinecastle Jeep Range; and

25 WHEREAS, the PJR Resolution contemplated that the ACoE would complete its
26 Feasibility Study Report by mid-2010 and therefore Section 7 of the PJR Resolution provides a
27 sunset date of June 1, 2010 "unless extended by the Orange County Board of County
28 Commissioners," and

29
30 WHEREAS, the ACoE has so far produced a "Draft Final" Feasibility Study Report and
31 is continuing with finalization of investigations, reviews of data, and public input; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to extend the PJR Resolution
34 and its enhanced requirements for permits and approvals for certain development activity within
35 the Pinecastle Jeep Range until June 2011, to allow for the finalization of the ACoE's reports;
36 and

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38 WHEREAS, in the course of its investigations, the ACoE altered and reduced the
39 boundary of the Pinecastle Jeep Range based on evidence of the area actually used by the U.S.
40 Government in the World War II era; and
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42 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to alter the boundary of the area
43 subject to the PJR Resolution such that it is consistent with the revised boundary now used by
44 the ACoE, see Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

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46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
47 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

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49 **Section 1.** The sunset date of Resolution No. 2008-M-11, "Resolution of the Orange
50 County Board of County Commissioners regarding Enhanced Requirements for Permits and
51 Approvals for Certain Development Activity within the Pinecastle Jeep Range" is hereby
52 extended until June 1, 2011, on which date it shall expire unless extended by the Board of
53 County Commissioners.

54 **Section 2.** Exhibit "A" to the PJR Resolution – a map showing the former parameters
55 of the Pinecastle Jeep Range – is hereby rescinded and replaced with **Exhibit "A"** attached to
56 this Resolution, showing revised boundaries of the Pinecastle Jeep Range.

57 **Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
