Regarding
**CERTAIN SERVICES FEES CHARGED BY THE
DISTRICT NINE MEDICAL EXAMINER**

Resolution No. 2010-M-59

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority by law to enact and, from time to time, amend fees charged by the various departments of the Orange County Government for various services rendered to the public; and

WHEREAS, the District Nine Medical Examiner is permitted by Florida Statute Chapter 406 to charge a fee for such services that captures the reasonable cost associated with administrative, personal services, operating, capital, and overhead to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Health Services Department has conducted a study to determine whether a cremation fee should be charged and determined from that study that 79% of Florida districts charge such fees; and

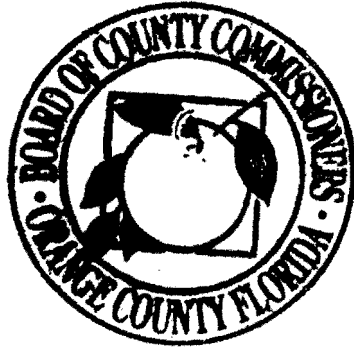
WHEREAS, the Orange County Health Services Department recommends that the Board approve the addition to the schedule of fees as to services rendered or for which application is made on or after October 1, 2010;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County hereby amends the existing fee schedule and establishes a new cremation fee of \$35.00 to become effective as to services rendered or for which application is made on or after October 1, 2010. The Board further determines that such fee may be adjusted annually, effective October 1 of each year, at a rate consistent with the consumer price index or 3%, whichever is less.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately, however the rate established hereby shall take effect on October 1, 2010.
