THE APPLICATION OF ORANGE COUNTY TO CO-HOST THE 2019, 2020, or 2021 NACo CONFERENCE IN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties (NACo) was created in 1935 to represent and advocate on behalf of county governments on national policy; and

WHEREAS, NACo provides extensive services to its members, including legislative, research, technical, public affairs and enterprise services; and

WHEREAS, NACo holds an annual conference and exposition that is jointly hosted by the organization and a member county; and

WHEREAS, NACo has issued a Request for Proposal to host the 2019, 2020, or 2021 Annual Conference and Exposition; and

WHEREAS, NACo expects that each conference and exposition will attract an estimated attendance of approximately 3200 visitors; and

WHEREAS, to fulfill the requirements of the proposal, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners must adopt of a resolution expressing support of the proposal by Orange County to co-host the 2019, 2020 or 2021 NACo Annual Conference and Exposition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1: Declaration of Support. Orange County Board of County
Commissioners supports bringing the National Association of Counties Annual
Conference and Exposition to Orange County, Florida in 2019, 2020 or 2021. Orange

County also agrees to assume the financial responsibilities incumbent on the host County.

Section 2: Directions to the Clerk. The Orange County Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Office of the Mayor to be submitted with the proposal.

Section 3: Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
