R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, The ORANGE COUNTY, hereinafter (name of agency applying for funds)

referred to as the Authority, is a district, special district, or other local authority as defined in the Department of Natural Resources' administrative rules Chapter 16C-15, and

WHEREAS, The Authority is responsible for Aquatic Plant Control as defined in the Department of Natural Resources' administrative rules Chapter 16C-15; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the rivers, streams, lakes, navigable waters and associated tributaries, canals, meandered lakes, enclosed water systems, and any other bodies of water, to be managed for Aquatic Plant Control with the use of funds from the total budget, which is comprised of local funds and the maximum allocation of state funds to be used for aquatic plant control, are accessible to both members of the general public and owners riparian to such waters, and/or which are managed for flood prevention.
