

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONTINUED
FUNDING BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA
OF THE NEW STATE CRIME LABORATORY
IN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has selected Orlando/
Orange County, Florida, as the site for a new crime
laboratory; and

WHEREAS, this new laboratory replaces an inadequate
facility now located in Sanford, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this new laboratory will be a major addition
to the law enforcement system of Central Florida; and

WHEREAS, the reduction in Sales Tax revenues to the
State Government has given rise to concerns that this
laboratory will not be constructed on schedule but possibly
delayed for several years; and

WHEREAS, one of the major reasons for the increased
Sales Tax was to improve law enforcement, and this project
is very important to the improvement of that critically
needed service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Board of County Commissioners urges
the Governor and Cabinet to continue the fund-
ing for the new crime laboratory to be
constructed in Orlando/Orange County, Florida.

SECTION 2. That, if the State Budget must be reduced to
meet available revenues, the reduction be
made in other areas which are not critical
to improved law enforcement.
