ONE PERCENT SALES TAX

RESOLUTION NO. 82-M-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING §212.057, FLORIDA STATUTES; LISTING THOSE PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED BY MONIES OBTAINED THEREBY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Public Hearing. The Board hereby calls for a public hearing to be held on September 14, 1982, for the purpose of considering enactment of an ordinance imposing an additional one percent sales tax for one year under the authority of §212.057, Florida Statutes. Such ordinance, if enacted, shall take effect only if approved by majority vote of those qualified electors of the County voting in a referendum to be held in conjunction with the 1982 General Election.

Section 2. Project List. To the extent available funds received from the imposition of the additional one percent sales tax shall be spent on the following projects, with priority to be determined:

- (a) Construction of improvements at the Orange County Convention/Civic Center.
- (b) Construction of an indoor arena in downtown Orlando.
- (c) Construction of an olympic swimming pool and water sports center at Valencia Community College, West Campus.
- (d) Construction of improvements at the Callahan Center for Black Culture and Performing Arts.
- (e) Construction of a pool at the Southwest Neighborhood Center.
- (f) Expansion of the Tangerine Bowl.
- (g) Construction of improvements at the Marks Street Senior Citizen's Center.

The following are additional projects to be considered by the Board of County Commissioners as funds permit:


(h) Construction of improvements at Winter Park Showalter Field.

(i) Construction of improvements at the Loch Haven Art Center.


(j) Construction of improvements at the John Young Science Center.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County will hold a public hearing on September 14, 1982, at 5:01 P.M., in Room 327 of the Orange County Courthouse to consider the following:

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX IN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1983; PROVIDING A SHORT TITLE AND IDENTIFYING THE AUTHORITY UNDER WHICH THE ORDINANCE IS ENACTED; IMPOSING THE ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 212.057, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1983 TO DECEMBER 31, 1983; IDENTIFYING THE PROJECTS TO BE FINANCED WITH PROCEEDS FROM THE TAX AND ESTIMATING EACH PROJECT COST; PROVIDING FOR INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS; PROVIDING FOR COUNTY ORDINANCE 78-7 (SECTION 33-108, ORANGE COUNTY CODE) TO PERMIT TAX PROCEEDS TO BE EXPENDED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CONVENTION/CIVIC CENTER; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATES OF THE SEVERAL SECTIONS; CALLING FOR REFERENDUM FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF THE ORDINANCE AND THE TAX IMPOSED THEREUNDER; PROVIDING A STATEMENT AND QUESTION TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT AT REFERENDUM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

As required by Ch. 80-150, Laws of Florida, the Orange County Board of Commissioners hereby notifies all interested parties that if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of County Commissioners with respect to any matter considered at such public hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

All interested parties are herein given notice.
