RESOLUTION #82-M-50

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 82-22 authorizing the designation of any Orange County Park as a "pay park" by setting a fee to be charged to the general public for admission; and

WHEREAS, said admission fee may be established on the basis of the means of admission by motor vehicle; and


WHEREAS, the criteria to be utilized in the computation of admission fees shall be reasonably related to expenses incurred by Orange County for the purchase and/or maintenance of the park for the entrance or use of which a fee is assessed by the Board and the duration or frequency of entrance into the park.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:


SECTION I: The Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts, based on evidence pertinent to said criteria placed before the Board this date, an admission fee to Moss Park of 50¢ per motor vehicle.

SECTION II: An amount equivalent to the park fees collected shall be allocated as an additional amount to that amount customarily allocated in the County budget for the purpose of County park capital improvements and maintenance of County park capital improvements.
