WHEREAS, Lake Jessamine is a large urban Lake with approximately 306 acres and


WHEREAS, Orange County has established a number of special purpose tax districts of property owners around these lakes to provide funds for materials used in various treatment programs. Each program is tailored for that particular lake's problem; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has a competent Pollution Control Department with technicians and equipment to study, implement and supervise these lake restoration projects; and


WHEREAS, as evidence of our competence, we had a three year contract with the Corps of Engineers to study and monitor a water quality experiment using the White Amur in the Lake Conway chain; and

WHEREAS, the present Game and Fish Commission rule (Chapter 39-8.10) concerning use of the White Amur is not responsive to the needs of the people of Orange County based on the criteria of the rule; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, requests and supports modification of the present rule to allow Counties with the technical expertise to utilize the White Amur in lakes of small and medium size which now have or are beginning to have, an aquatic plant problem to improve water quality and usage. These improvement programs are to have the financial support and approval of the surrounding property owners. This policy is to apply to both public and private lakes.
