RESOLUTION NO. 83-M-07

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE ORANGE-OSCEOLA
COUNTY PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL AND STATING
INITIAL APPOINTMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Counties of Orange and Osceola have been desig-
nated a service delivery area by the Governor of Florida under
the terms of, and in accord with, the Job Training Partnership
Act of 1982, and

WHEREAS, the said Job Training Partnership Act of 1982
requires that the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County
create a private Industry Council and select members therefor in
accord with Section 102 of said Act.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE
COUNTY:

Section 1. The Orange-Osceola County Private Industry
Council, composed of fifteen (15) members, is hereby created and
shall act in accord with such powers granted it under the Job
Training Partnership Act of 1982.

Section 2. The initial appointments to said Private Industry
Council, the sector which these appointees represent as defined
in the Job Training Partnership Act of 1982, and the employer
and nominating organization of each employee are as follows:

For a term of One Year, terminating December 31, 1984;
provided, however, that these parties initially appointed
shall serve more than one year during their initial term:

Section 3. Commencing with appointments by this Board to
the Private Industry Council effective December 1, 1984, all
appointments shall be made for a term of two (2) years.

Section 4. This Board hereby satisfies all earlier consistent action taken by the Board consistent with the terms of this Resolution.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

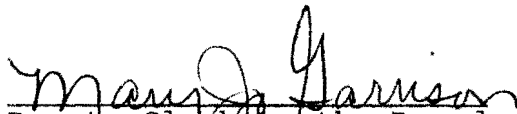

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE FLORIDA RECREATION DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM PROJECT AGREEMENT FOR TRIMBLE PARK.

WHEREAS, The County is desirous of developing Trimble Park to provide outdoor recreation for the people to enjoy during their leisure time.

WHEREAS, The County intends to construct, or cause to be constructed, the facilities according to the attached approved plan.

WHEREAS, Orange County shall operate and maintain the project after completion for a minimum period of 25 years or the expected life of the project--whichever is greater.


WHEREAS, The County of Orange will contribute as its share \$49,000 from the County Capital Improvement Fund.

WHEREAS, The County became a political subdivision in the year 1845, A.D.

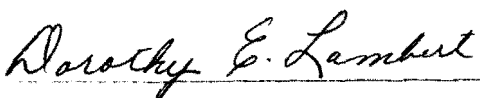
