RESOLUTION NO. 83-M-12

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, met on July 5, 1983 to consider proposed amendments to the Orange County Right-of-Way Utilization Regulations as adopted by Ordinance No. 81-8, amended by Ordinance No. 82-6, and codified in Section 26-39 of the Orange County Code.

2. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 79-32, the Board of County Commissioners must consider the short and long term public and private costs and benefits of any new or proposed changes to existing County ordinances that the Board determines to have a substantial impact on the development of, and construction on, real property within Orange County.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners determines that the proposed amendments to the Right-of-Way Utilization Regulations considered by the Board on July 5, 1983 will not have a substantial economic impact on the development of, and construction on, real property within Orange County and the Board further determines that sufficient information has been provided for the Board to assess the economic impact of the proposed changes.
