RESOLUTION NO. 83-M-13

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO GAS TAXES IN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; EXPRESSING THE COUNTY'S INTENT TO IMPOSE A FOUR-CENT LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 336.025, FLORIDA STATUTES, WITHIN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA.

PREMISES

1. On June 20, 1983, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida adopted Orange County Ordinance No. 83-26, imposing a four-cent gas tax on each gallon of motor fuel and special fuel sold in Orange County.

2. The County has not yet executed an interlocal agreement regarding distribution of the gas tax among the municipalities in Orange County. Chapter 336.025, Florida Statutes, provides that if no interlocal agreement is executed by July 15th, the Board of County Commissioner may adopt a resolution declaring its intent to impose the gas tax.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County hereby declares its intent, as further evidenced by the adoption of Orange County Ordinance No. 83-26, to impose a four-cent gas tax on each gallon of motor fuel and special fuel sold in Orange County.
