

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Orange County Tourist Development Council has unanimously recommended that the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County request authorization from the Florida legislature to increase the tourist development tax from 2 percent per dollar to 4 percent per dollar; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that such action is consistent with the County plan for tourist development;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

THAT, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida does hereby authorize and direct the County Administrator to take all actions necessary and appropriate to introduce to the Florida legislature amendments to Chapter 125.0104, Florida Statutes, which provide for an increase in the tourist development tax.
