CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC. AS ORANGE COUNTY'S AGENT FOR CHILD CARE SERVICES



RESOLUTION NO. 85-M-06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHAIRMAN  
TO EXECUTE LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH  
SEABOARD SYSTEM RAILROAD, INC.

WHEREAS, Orange County has made application to Seaboard System Railroad, Inc. for installation of a 54" effluent transmission pipeline across the Railroad's right-of-way along Eighth Street at or near Gotha, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Railroad has agreed to allow said installation subject to certain terms and conditions as outlined in the license agreement dated February 25, 1985; now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. That the Chairman of said Board be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into an agreement with the SEABOARD SYSTEM RAILROAD, INC., and to sign same on behalf of said County whereby said Railroad grants unto said County the right or license to install and maintain a sewage effluent pipeline beneath the right-of-way, from which tracks of the Railroad have been removed, at Gotha, Florida, as particularly described in said agreement, which agreement is dated February 25, 1985, a copy of which agreement is filed with the Board of County Commissioners.
