RESOLUTION NO. 85-M-07

WHEREAS, on October 15, 1984, ORANGE COUNTY enacted its Fairness in Procurement Ordinance to encourage the number of minority-owned and women-owned businesses doing business with the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Ordinance, the Board of County Commissioners desires to establish a Purchasing Review Committee to serve in an advisory capacity to County staff in implementing the Fairness in Procurement Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners does hereby establish a committee to be designated the Purchasing Review Committee whose purpose shall be to serve in an advisory capacity to the County's compliance officer and other county staff in implementing the goals of the County's Fairness in Procurement Ordinance and to aid in the establishment of procedures to effectuate the purposes of said Ordinance.

Section 2. The Purchasing Review Committee shall consist of members, each of whom shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, to serve two (2) year terms, which terms shall commence on the date of appointment. Each member shall be a resident of Orange County.

Section 3. Each appointee shall serve without pay and shall receive no compensation for travel expenses or other costs, unless such be approved by the Board of County Commissioners prior to such cost or expense being incurred.

Section 4. The Board of County Commissioners shall appoint a new member to fill the unexpired term of any member who resigns or is removed from the committee prior to expiration of the member's term.

Section 5. At the conclusion of the two year term, the Board of County Commissioners may reappoint the individual committee members or may appoint new members or may abolish said committee entirely if so desired.

Section 6. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this resolution are declared severable.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
