A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH APOPKA IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF EDUCATIONAL AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Orange County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, desires to provide educational and recreational programs; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has determined that this is a valid county purpose for the expenditure of public funds and that the interests of the citizens of Orange County are served by contracting with a nongovernmental entity to perform these services; and

WHEREAS, Apopka Improvement Association, Inc. performs such services in the course of its activities and operations; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has the power, under §125.01, Fla. Stat., as further defined in Orange County Ordinance No. 78-23, to contract for the provision of such services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Orange County is authorized to enter into an agreement with Apopka Improvement Association, Inc. for the provision of educational and recreational programs for the period April 1, 1985 to September 30, 1985.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
