

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING
COUNTY POLICY REGARDING
A POSSIBLE HALF-MILL
TAX FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the County Commission has tentatively established a half-mill of ad valorem taxes in the 1985-86 budget for capital requirements of the community; and

WHEREAS, these revenues will be established in a special fund as provided by state law and can be used for a variety of infrastructure needs such as primary stormwater, secondary drainage, park lands, sidewalks, bicycle paths, rights-of-way, roads, land acquisition, engineering designs and a variety of other expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has under consideration an impact fee for transportation needs which will not be adopted prior to consideration of this special millage at the public hearings in September; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Commission to establish its policy on this millage as it relates to the impact fee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. THAT, it is the policy of the Board that any revenues derived from a half-mill or other increase for capital improvement will not be considered in any formula establishing a future impact fee for roads.
