

MILLAGE RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR THE ORANGE COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT; STATING THE PERCENTAGE BY WHICH THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE AS ADOPTED HEREIN EXCEEDS THE INDIVIDUAL ROLLED BACK MILLAGE RATE; STATING THE PERCENTAGE INCREASE OF PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE ORANGE COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PREMISES

1. The Orange County Library District, as the taxing authority for the purposes and for the entities identified below, pursuant to F.S. 200.065, established a rolled back rate, for each purpose and for each entity identified below, at a public meeting scheduled to consider adoption of the proposed millage, held on July 25, 1985.

2. At public hearings scheduled to consider the adoption of tentative budgets and tentative millages, the initial hearing for which was held beginning at 7:00 p.m. on September 4, 1985, Orange County adopted tentative budgets and tentative millages for the purposes and for the entities set forth below.

3. A public hearing was held beginning at 7:00 p.m. on September 11, 1985, to adopt final millage rates for the purposes and for the entities identified below.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LIBRARY DISTRICT GOVERNING BOARD:

Section 1. The following final millages rates are hereby established and fixed for the following purposes and entities; and, the associated percentages are the percentages by which the millage rates adopted herein exceed the rolled back millage rate for each of the following purposes and entities:

| <u>Fund</u> | <u>Millage</u> | <u>Percentage Increase/Decrease</u> |

| Library Operating | 0.4422 | 3.0 |
| Library Construction | 0.1720 | -9.1 |
| Aggregate | 0.6142 | -0.7 |

Section 2. The percentages set forth in the immediately preceding section are the percentage increases or decreases in property taxes for each of the foregoing purposes and entities.

Section 3. The final millage rates set forth above and the percentage increases set forth above are adopted for the year commencing October 1, 1985, and ending September 30, 1986, and for the purposes specified in F.S. 200.065.

Section 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.

Section 5. The Tax Collector shall be, and is hereby authorized and instructed to collect the taxes as assessed by the Property Appraiser in accordance with this resolution, and to deposit each week the funds so collected in the duly designated district depositories, if he finds upon inquiry from the office of the Comptroller that there is ample security for the additional deposits to be made; all the funds to be under the control of the Board of Orange County Commissioners, as trustee, to be deposited in an account reading "Board of Orange County Commissioners," in the Southeast Bank of Miami, N.A. (Region Four), Orlando, Florida.

Section 6. That copies of this resolution be furnished to the Property Appraiser, Tax Collector, and the Department of Revenue.
