

RESOLUTION NO. 86-m-22 JUN 30 1986

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A VETERANS ADMINISTRATION HOSPITAL IN ORANGE COUNTY; DIRECTING THE CLERK TO FORWARD COPIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Veterans Administration has proposed construction of a veterans hospital in Central Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Veterans Administration has received an offer of property for the proposed hospital in Orange County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that location of the proposed VA hospital in Orange County would reach more veterans in Orange, Seminole, Volusia and Brevard Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County finds that location of the proposed VA hospital in Orange County would be accessible to veterans in Orange, Seminole, Volusia and Brevard Counties.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Orange County supports location of a proposed Veterans Administration hospital in Orange County.

Section 2. The Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners is directed to forward copies of this Resolution to the U.S. Veterans Administration, the U.S. General Accounting Office and the U.S. Congressional Delegation for Orange County.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
