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RESOLUTION NO. 86-M-53

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT FLORIDA GYPSUM SERVICES WILL ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITY OF MAINTENANCE FOR A RAILROAD-GRADE CROSSING (AND RAILROAD SIGNAL WHEN AND IF INSTALLED) INSTALLATION AT 1700 WEST NEW HAMPSHIRE AVENUE, 2041' SOUTH OF MILE POST ST-812, ORLANDO, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, Orange County, Florida has approved the construction of a railroad crossing of the New Hampshire Avenue;

WHEREAS, in order for the Florida Department of Transportation to process any work on the proposed crossing; and

WHEREAS, before an application can be completed with the Department of Transportation that this resolution be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. Florida Gypsum Services assumes the responsibility for annual maintenance costs of the proposed Railroad Crossing (and Railroad Signal when and if installed) at 1700 West New Hampshire Avenue. This cost is to be approximately, but shall not be limited to, \$2,000.00 per year.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
