2 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
3 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
4 PERTAINING TO THE REPORT PREPARED BY THE  
5 ALLIANCE FOR A BETTER CENTRAL FLORIDA  
6 ENTITLED "FUNDING LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEEDS: A  
7 PRIVATE SECTOR SOLUTION"; PROVIDING THAT THE  
8 BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE  
9 COUNTY, FLORIDA SUPPORT IN CONCEPT THE  
10 REPORT ENTITLED "FUNDING LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
11 NEEDS: A PRIVATE SECTOR SOLUTION" AND  
12 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

13 WHEREAS, Article VIII, Section 1(g), Florida  
14 Constitution, 1968, and Article I, Section 103, Orange County  
15 Charter, provide that counties operating under county  
16 charters shall have all powers of local self-government not  
17 inconsistent with general law or with special law approved by  
18 vote of the electors;

19 WHEREAS, the Alliance for a Better Central Florida is a  
20 coalition of distinct organizations in Orange, Osceola and  
21 Seminole counties which desires to more effectively present  
22 the community interest in the preservation and enhancement of  
23 the quality of life in Central Florida;

24 WHEREAS, the Alliance for a Better Central Florida  
25 recognizes the transportation needs of Central Florida;

26 WHEREAS, the Alliance for a Better Central Florida seeks  
27 to develop a framework leading to a comprehensive integrated  
28 transportation plan meeting the transportation needs of the  
29 citizens of Central Florida;

30 WHEREAS, the Alliance for a Better Central Florida has  
31 prepared a report entitled "Funding Local Government Needs:  
32 A Private Sector Solution";

33 WHEREAS, the report entitled "Funding Local Government  
34 Needs: A Private Sector Solution," proposes various  
35 solutions to the transportation problems in Central Florida;

36 WHEREAS, the solutions proposed by the Alliance for a  
Better Central Florida in the report entitled "Funding Local  
Government Needs: A Private Sector Solution" include, but  
are not limited to, enacting legislation which provides for  
new revenues;

1 WHEREAS, the new revenues, proposed by the Alliance for a  
2 Better Central Florida in the report entitled "Funding Local  
3 Government Needs: A Private Sector Solution," include a one  
4 percent sales tax and an increased gas tax; and

5 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to  
6 the home rule powers granted by the Constitution of the State  
7 of Florida and the Orange County Charter, desires to adopt a  
8 resolution not inconsistent with general law or special law  
9 approved by vote of the electors pertaining to the report  
10 entitled "Funding Local Government Needs: A Private Sector  
11 Solution" submitted to said Board by the Alliance for a  
12 Better Central Florida.

13 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
14 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

15 SECTION 1. REPORT ENTITLED "FUNDING LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
16 NEEDS: A PRIVATE SECTOR SOLUTION." The Board of County  
17 Commissioners support in concept the report submitted by the  
18 Alliance for a Better Central Florida entitled "Funding Local  
19 Government Needs: A Private Sector Solution."

20 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become  
21 effective on the date of its adoption.
