3 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM SPEED
4 LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR FOR THE RESI-
5 DENTIAL DISTRICT KNOWN AS Lynnwood Estates
6 1st Addition, Lynnwood Estates and Replat of Block C
7 Lynnwood Estates 1st Addition.

8 WHEREAS, Section 316.189 and Section 316.183, Florida
9 Statutes, as amended by Chapter 88-47, Laws of Florida,
10 authorizes a county to set a maximum speed limit of 25 miles
11 per hour for a residential district after an investigation
12 determines that such a limit is reasonable; and

13 WHEREAS, Orange County has determined after an investi-
14 gation that the maximum speed limit should be 25 miles per
15 hour for the residential district known as Lynnwood Estates
16 1st Addition, Lynnwood Estates and Replat of Block C, Lynnwood Estates
17 1st Addition.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COM-
19 MISSION OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

20 1. The maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour
21 for all streets located within the residential district known
22 as Lynnwood Estates 1st Addition, Lynnwood Estates and Replat of Block C.
23 Lynnwood Estates 1st Addition.

24 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the
25 date of its adoption.
