RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-24

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO ANIMAL CONTROL;
AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORANGE COUNTY
RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-03; AMENDING SECTION 4
OF ORANGE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 88-M-03 AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 22, 1987, the Orange County Commission established the Orange County Spay and Neuter Program Ad Hoc Committee, hereinafter referred to as the "Committee."

WHEREAS, on January 25, 1988, the Orange County Commission adopted Resolution No. 88-M-03 establishing rules and regulations for the enforcement of the Orange County Animal Control Ordinance.

WHEREAS, on February 1, 1988, the Committee made recommendations to the Orange County Commission regarding the implementation of an effective spay and neuter program within Orange County, Florida.

WHEREAS, the Orange County Commission desires to amend Sections 3 and 4 of Orange County Resolution No. 88-M-03 based upon the recommendations of the Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY COMMISSION:

Section 1. Section 3 of Orange County Resolution No. 88-M-03, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. Pursuant to Section 3-15 and Section 3-16, Orange County Code, the Orange County Commission hereby establishes a fee for the issuance of rabies vaccination tags to owners of animals in Orange County as follows:

(a) Dog Tag	\$6-00	<u>\$10.00</u>
(b) Cat Tag	6-00	<u>10.00</u>
(c) Replacement Tag	1.00	
(d) Transfer of Ownership Tag	1.00	

1 Section 2. Section 4 of Orange County Resolution No.
2 88-M-03 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 4. Pursuant to Section 3-16, Orange County
4 Code, the Orange County Commission hereby
5 establishes a discount of ~~four~~ eight dollars
6 (~~\$4.00~~ \$8.00) per animal for rabies vaccination
7 tag fees to the owners and keepers of neutered
8 and spayed animals. Therefore, owners and
9 keepers of neutered and spayed animals may obtain
10 rabies vaccination tags upon payment of two
11 dollars (\$2.00) per animal. The discount fee for
12 neutered and spayed animals shall be allowed upon
13 presentation of a written notice of spaying or
14 castration signed by a veterinarian licensed in
15 any state, proof of the dog's or cat's permanent
16 inability to reproduce, certified by a
17 veterinarian licensed in any state, or proof of
18 prior issuance of a tag for the dog or cat at the
19 discounted fee.

20 Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect upon
21 adoption.
