2 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BE-
3 TWEEN ORANGE COUNTY AND THE DIVISION OF
4 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF THE FLORIDA
5 DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, AND ACCEPTING FUTURE
6 MAINTENANCE AND ATTENDANT COSTS IN CONNEC-
7 TION WITH THE ALAFAYA TRAIL CONSTRUCTION
8 PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, the Division of Economic Development of the
11 Florida Department of Commerce, hereinafter referred to as
12 the "Division", has determined that the paving of
13 approximately 0.66 miles of Alafaya Trail from Centaurus Road
14 north to the Orange-Seminole County Line in connection with
15 the expansion of facilities by the Harris Corporation is
16 necessary to facilitate the economic development of the State
17 of Florida as contemplated in Section 288.063, Florida
18 Statutes, and as set forth in the Economic Development
19 Transportation Fund application attached to the agreement
20 between the County and the Division; and

21 WHEREAS, the County is prepared to complete the project.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION
23 OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

24 1. The Chairman is hereby authorized to execute, on
25 behalf of the County, an Agreement between the County and the
26 Division; which Agreement is attached hereto as "Exhibit A",
27 and which includes an Economic Development Transportation
28 Fund Application which is attached thereto.

29 2. The County hereby assures the Division that the
30 County will do as follows:

- 31 a. carry the project through to its completion;
32 b. be responsible for all cost overruns on the
33 project;
34 c. design and construct the project in accordance
35 with standards established in the agreement;
36 d. accept future maintenance and attendant costs
in connection with the project.

37 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon approval
38 of its adoption.
