RESOLUTION NO. 89- LEG-03

WHEREAS, there has been proposed a bill in the Florida Legislature to allow county governments to increase the tourist development tax another cent to a maximum of four cents on each dollar and major fraction of each dollar of the total consideration charged for lease or rental of premises as set forth in Section 125.0104(3) of the Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commission of Orange County, Florida met on February 27, 1989, at a public meeting to discuss the proposed legislation and use of revenues generated by the additional cent of tourist development tax; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commission desires to express its position with regard to the authority to impose an additional fourth cent of that tax;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

That the Board of County Commission of Orange County, Florida supports the proposal to allow county governments to impose in accordance with Section 125.0104(3)(d) a fourth cent of the tourist development tax with the revenues generated from such additional cent to be used by local governments for those purposes and uses currently authorized in Section 125.0104(5), Florida Statutes.
