

1 RESOLUTION NO. 89-M-04

2 ESTABLISHING AND EMPOWERING THE ORANGE  
3 COUNTY AD HOC COMMITTEE ON ANIMAL CONTROL  
4 AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS  
5 THERETO.

6 WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
7 County, Florida, on March 9, 1987, adopted Ordinance No.  
8 87-9, codified as Chapter 3, Article I, Orange County Code,  
9 and entitled the "Orange County Animal Control Ordinance";

10 WHEREAS, said Ordinance became effective on March 23,  
11 1987;

12 WHEREAS, Section 125.01(1)(t), Florida Statutes, provides  
13 in pertinent part that the governing body of a county shall,  
14 to the extent not inconsistent with general or special law,  
15 adopt resolutions necessary for the exercise of its powers;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
18 County, Florida, pursuant to Section 125.01(1)(t), Florida  
19 Statutes, desires to create the Orange County Ad Hoc  
20 Committee on Animal Control to review Orange County Ordinance  
21 No. 87-9, to examine the animal control ordinances of  
22 municipalities and other counties within the State of Florida  
23 and to develop recommendations on amending Orange County  
24 Ordinance No. 87-9.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
26 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

27 Section 1. Creation and Purpose. The Orange County Ad  
28 Hoc Committee on Animal Control, hereinafter referred to as  
29 the "Committee," is hereby created to review Orange County  
30 Ordinance No. 87-9, to examine the animal control ordinances  
31 of municipalities and other counties within the State of  
32 Florida and to develop recommendations on amending Orange  
33 County Ordinance No. 87-9.

1           Section 2.    Membership.

2           (a) The Committee shall be composed of seven (7)  
3 members all of whom shall be appointed by the Board of County  
4 Commissioners of Orange County, Florida. Each of the members  
5 of the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County,  
6 Florida, shall recommend one (1) individual residing in the  
7 nominating member's district for appointment to the  
8 Committee. The remaining two (2) appointees to the Committee  
9 shall be individuals recommended to the Board of County  
10 Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, from a list of at  
11 least three (3) nominees submitted by the Tri-County League  
12 of Cities. The nominees submitted by the Tri-County League  
13 of Cities shall be staff persons employed by cities within  
14 Orange County which are members of the Tri-County League of  
15 Cities. None of the nominees submitted to the Board of  
16 County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida by the  
17 Tri-County League of Cities shall be elected officials.

18           (b) The members of the Committee shall be appointed  
19 for a term of one (1) year, commencing on February 6, 1989,  
20 and terminating on February 5, 1990.

21           (c) The members of the Committee may be removed for  
22 cause upon a majority vote of the Board of County  
23 Commissioners of Orange County, Florida. If any member of  
24 the Committee resigns, dies, or is removed for cause from the  
25 Committee, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
26 County, Florida, shall, within thirty (30) days, fill such  
27 vacancy by appointment. Such appointment shall be for the  
28 unexpired term of the office of the member so removed.

29           (d) The Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
30 County, Florida, may remove any member who, without  
31 reasonable cause, fails to attend three (3) meetings of the  
32 Committee.

33           Section 3.    Organization.

34           (a) The organizational meeting of the Committee  
35 shall be held no later than March 1, 1989. At its  
36 organizational meeting, the Committee shall elect from its

1 membership, a Chairman and Vice-Chairman. Further meetings  
2 of the Committee shall be held upon the request of the  
3 Chairman or a majority of the members of the Committee. All  
4 meetings shall be open to the public. A majority of the  
5 members of the Committee shall constitute a quorum.

6 (b) The Committee may adopt such other rules for  
7 its operations and proceedings as it deems necessary.

8 (c) The Committee may form subcommittees from its  
9 membership. These subcommittees shall concentrate their  
10 efforts on reviewing the various animal control ordinances  
11 adopted by municipalities and other counties within the State  
12 of Florida and receiving input from veterinarians, law  
13 enforcement officers, various agencies concerned with the  
14 treatment and care of animals, including, but not limited to,  
15 the Humane Society of Orlando and Central Florida Action for  
16 Animals Homeowners' Association and the general public.

17 (d) Members of the Committee shall receive no  
18 compensation, but shall be reimbursed for reasonable  
19 expenses, subject to any limitations imposed by the annual  
20 County budgetary process.

21 Section 4. Reports. The Committee shall submit a  
22 written report to the Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
23 County, Florida, on or before August 15, 1989, outlining its  
24 preliminary findings. The Committee shall submit a final  
25 written report to the Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
26 County, Florida, on or before October 1, 1989, outlining its  
27 findings and recommendations. Interim reports shall be  
28 submitted by the Committee at the request of the Board of  
29 County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida.

30 Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this  
31 Resolution or the application thereof to any person or  
32 circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of this Resolution which can  
34 be given effect without the invalid provision or application  
35 and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are  
36 declared severable.

1            Section 6. Effective Date.    This Resolution shall  
2 become effective upon the date of passage.
