RESOLUTION NO. 89-M-08

WHEREAS, under the terms of Public Law 89-564, Title 23, USC, Section 402, has authorized the National Highway Safety Administration (NHTSA) through the State of Florida, Bureau of Public Safety Management, acting as an application clearinghouse, to process such applications; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has examined and duly considered such Act, and the Applicant considers it to be in the public interest and to its benefit to file an application under said Act and to authorized other action in connection therewith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That development of the project generally described above is in the best interest of the Applicant and the general public.

2. That WALTER J. GALLAGHER, Sheriff, Orange County, Florida is hereby authorized to file on behalf of the Applicant an application in the form prescribed by the State of Florida, Bureau of Public Safety Management in the conformity with said Act, for a grant to be made to the Applicant to assist in defraying the cost of the project generally described above.

3. That if such grant be made, the Applicant shall provide or make necessary arrangements to provide such funds and/or in-kind contributions in addition to the grant as may be required by the Act to defray to cost of the project generally described above.

4. That said WALTER J. GALLAGHER, Sheriff, Orange County, Florida, is hereby authorized to furnish such information and take such other action as may be necessary to enable the Applicant to qualify for said grant.

5. That the Official designated in the preceding paragraph is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the Applicant for the purpose of furnishing to the Florida Bureau of Public Safety Management such information, data and documents pertaining to the application for said grant as may be required and otherwise to act as the authorized representative of the Applicant in connection with this application.

6. That certified copies of this resolution be included as part of the application for said grant to be submitted to the Florida Bureau of Public Safety Management.

7. That if such grant be made, the Applicant or Official designated in paragraph 4 above shall maintain such records necessary and furnish such information, data and documents as required by the Florida Bureau of Public Safety Management to support the implementation of the project generally described above.



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8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
