RESOLUTION NO. 89-M-111

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY WATER EQUIPMENT TO
LAKE COUNTY, A DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE
OF FLORIDA.

PREMISES

1. The Orange County Commission is in receipt of the application of Lake County for conveyance to it of two surplus 10,000 gallon and one 5,000 gallon hydro-pneumatic tanks which are presently County property.
2. The Orange County Commission finds that said Lake County is a valid division of local government of the State of Florida.
3. The Orange County Commission has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus water equipment, namely:

One 10,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank located at Rock Springs Water Plant, .

One 10,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank located at Corrine Terrace Water Plant,

One 5,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank located at Hunter's Creek

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Orange County Commission, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to other political subdivisions of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Orange County shall and hereby does convey the following property at no cost to Lake County, namely:

One 10,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank located at Rock Springs Water Plant

One 10,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank located at Corrine Terrace Water Plant

One 5,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank located at Hunter's Creek

and the County Administrator, be and hereby is, authorized to execute on behalf of the County all documents necessary to accomplish transfer of title thereto. Lake County will remove said property from Rock Springs Water Plant, Corrine Terrace Water Plant, and Hunter's Creek at no cost or liability to Orange County.
