

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY FIRE EQUIPMENT TO  
ORANGE COUNTY RADIO AMATEUR COMMUNICATIONS EMERGENCY  
SERVICES, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION.

PREMISES

1. The Board of County Commissioners is in receipt of application for conveyance to it of 25 antenna sections which are presently County property.
2. The Board of County Commissioners finds that the Orange County Radio Amateur Communications Emergency Services group is a valid non-profit organization, organized for the purposes of promoting community interest and welfare.
3. The Board of County Commissioners has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus communications equipment, namely:

Twenty-Five (25) antenna tower sections

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Board of County Commissioners, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to non-profit organizations of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Orange county shall and hereby does convey the following property at no cost to the Orange County Radio Amateur Communications Emergency Services, namely:

Twenty-Five (25) antenna tower sections

and the County Administrator, be and hereby is authorized to execute on behalf of the County all documents necessary to accomplish transfer of title thereto. Radio Amateur Communications Emergency Services will remove said property from Orange County Fire Rescue Communications Center at no cost or liability to Orange County.
