# Resolution

WHEREAS, a construction worker is recognized as a dedicated individual performing a dangerous occupation; and

WHEREAS, a construction worker performs duties that are strenuous, and involve possible risk, loss or injury; and

WHEREAS, Leron Jackson was a dedicated construction worker who performed construction duties on Phase II of the Orange County Convention/Civic Center Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, while performing his duties Leron Jackson accidentally slipped and fell; and

WHEREAS, Leron Jackson died as a result of his injuries on May 30, 1988;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida

Section 1. That the Board of County Commissioners commemorates in this Resolution the dedicated service of Leron Jackson and offers to his family our heartfelt sympathy and condolences on his passing.

Section 2. That a donation be made to Great Oaks Village, a center for abused, abandoned and neglected children, in memory of Leron Jackson.

Section 3. That this Resolution be spread upon the records of this county as a perpetual recognition of the importance of the contribution of Leron Jackson to the expansion of the Orange County Convention/Civic Center.
