A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH APOPKA IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR PROVISION OF SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Orange County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, desires to provide summer recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has determined that this is a valid county purpose for the expenditure of public funds and that the interests of the citizens of Orange County are served by contracting with a nongovernmental entity to perform these services; and

WHEREAS, Apopka Improvement Association, Inc. performs such services in the course of its activities and operations; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has the power, under Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, as further defined in Orange County Ordinance No. 78-23, to contract for provision of such services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Orange County is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Apopka Improvement Association, Inc. for provision of summer recreation programs for the term October 1, 1989 through September 30, 1990.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
