A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ORANGE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CENTER FOR DRUG-FREE LIVING, INC. FOR PROVISION OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Orange County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, desires to provide substance abuse prevention services; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has determined that this is a valid county purpose for the expenditure of public funds and that the interests of the citizens of Orange County are served by contracting with a nongovernmental entity to perform these services; and

WHEREAS, The Center for Drug-Free Living, Inc. performs such services in the course of its activities and operations; and

WHEREAS, Orange County has the power, under Section 125.01, Florida Statutes, as further defined in Orange County Ordinance No. 78-23, to contract for provision of such services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Orange County is authorized to enter into an Agreement with The Center for Drug-Free Living, Inc. for provision of substance abuse prevention services for the term of October 1, 1989, through September 30, 1990.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
