<u>Section 1</u>. Orange County is authorized to enter into an Agreement with The Center for Drug-Free Living, Inc. for provision of substance abuse prevention services for the term of October 1, 1989, through September 30, 1990.

<u>Section 2</u>. This resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
