RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-08

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY FIRE EQUIPMENT TO  
ASTOR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT A DIVISION OF LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA.

PREMISES

1. The Orange County Board of Commissioners is in receipt of the application of Astor Volunteer Fire Department for conveyance to it of one surplus fire truck which is presently County property.
2. The Orange County Board of Commissioners finds the said Astor Volunteer Fire Department is a valid division of local government of the State of Florida.
3. The Orange County Board of Commissioners has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus fire equipment, namely:

One (1) fire truck, 1967 Ward LaFrance, County Number 850025, VIN 85502

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Orange County Board of Commissioners by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to other political subdivisions of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Orange County shall and hereby does convey the following property to Astor Volunteer Fire Department, namely:

One fire truck, 1967, Ward LaFrance, County Number 850025, VIN 85502  
\$3500.00

and the County Administrator, be and hereby, authorized to execute on behalf of the County all documents necessary to accomplish transfer of title thereto. Astor Volunteer Fire Department will remove said property from Orange County Property Accounting storage area at no cost or liability to Orange County.
