

RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-10

A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING ORANGE COUNTY'S
MAJOR EMPLOYERS TO DEVELOP PROGRAMS WHICH
WILL OFFER INCREASED HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES
FOR THEIR EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange
County, Florida, recognized the need for affordable housing
and established the Orange County Affordable Housing Task
Force pursuant to Resolution No. 88-M-22 on April 25, 1988;
and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Affordable Housing Task Force
has completed its work and made its recommendations to the
Board of County Commissioners for consideration; and

WHEREAS, recommendation No. 7 made by the Task Force is
to encourage major employers to develop programs which would
increase housing opportunities for their employees and to
participate actively in ongoing strategies which address the
affordability issue; and

WHEREAS, major employers may be able to develop and offer
alternative benefit programs, including housing assistance
plans, which will increase housing opportunities for their
employees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to
promote the use of employee benefit programs to provide
additional housing opportunities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that major employers
in Orange County are encouraged to develop employee benefit
programs to meet affordable housing needs and to participate
actively in ongoing strategies which address the housing
affordability issue.

This Resolution shall become effective upon the date
adopted.
