RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-11

1 A RESOLUTION ENCOURAGING THE UTILIZATION OF  
2 SUITABLE PUBLICLY-OWNED LAND FOR DEVELOPMENT  
3 OF AFFORDABLE LOW AND MODERATE INCOME  
HOUSING.

4 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange  
5 County, Florida, recognized the need for affordable housing  
6 and established the Orange County Affordable Housing Task  
7 Force pursuant to Resolution No. 88-M-22 on April 25, 1988;  
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the Orange County Affordable Housing Task Force  
10 has completed its work and made its recommendations to the  
11 Board of County Commissioners for consideration; and

12 WHEREAS, recommendation No. 8 made by the Task Force is  
13 to review the inventory of County-owned land and make those  
14 sites that are appropriate for housing available for that  
15 purpose either to developers through a competitive proposal  
16 process or by direct grant to private non-profit agencies; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to  
18 promote use of publicly-owned land for the development of  
19 affordable housing for low and moderate income residents; and

20 WHEREAS, a statewide inventory analysis conducted for the  
21 Florida Department of Community Affairs identified parcels of  
22 public land in Orange County owned by local governments,  
23 special districts and other public agencies which may be  
24 suitable for affordable housing development.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY  
26 COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that all  
27 municipalities, special districts and other public agencies  
28 be encouraged to utilize publicly-owned land that is  
29 appropriate for housing for low and moderate income housing  
30 development.

31 This Resolution shall become effective upon the date  
32 adopted.
