RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY PROPOSING SUBMISSION OF TENTATIVE BUDGETS FOR THE CLERK OF COURTS, COMPTROLLER, SHERIFF, AND SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Subsection (2) of Section 129.03 of the Florida Statutes amended as follows: "On or before June 1 of each year, the sheriff, the clerk of the circuit court and county comptroller, the tax collector subject to a resolution entered into pursuant to F.S. 145.022 (1), and the supervisor of elections shall each submit to the board of county commissioners a tentative budget for their respective offices for the ensuing fiscal year. However, the board of county commissioners may, by resolution, require the tentative budgets to be submitted by May 1 of each year."

WHEREAS, due to time constraints in the budget review process the Board of County Commissioners, Orange County, Florida has determined that May 1 of each year shall be the date to submit tentative budgets for the above mentioned constitutional officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Orange County Sheriff, Comptroller, Supervisor of Elections, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court are required to submit their tentative budgets for each fiscal year by May 1.

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
