RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-41

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING SURPLUS COUNTY EQUIPMENT TO THE  
CITY OF APOPKA, A DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE  
STATE OF FLORIDA.

PREMISES

1. The Orange County Board of Commissioners is in receipt of the application of the City of Apopka for conveyance to it of one vehicle which is presently County property.
2. The Orange County Board of Commissioners finds that said City of Apopka is a valid division of local government of the State of Florida.
3. The Orange County Board of Commissioners has been informed and hereby finds, that the County presently owns certain surplus equipment, namely:

One(1) Van, 1984 Ford, County Number 005006, VIN 1FBHS31G74EHA37764

which property is no longer of use to the County and no longer needed for County purposes.

4. The Orange County Board of Commissioners, by virtue of Section 125.38 Florida Statutes, is authorized to convey surplus County property no longer of use to or required by the County, to other political subdivisions of the State of Florida.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ORANGE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Orange County shall and hereby does convey the following property to the City of Apopka, namely:

One(1) Van, 1984 Ford, County Number 005006, VIN 1FBHS31G74EHA37764

and the County Administrator be and hereby is authorized to execute on behalf of the County all documents necessary to accomplish transfer of title thereto. The City of Apopka will remove said property from Orange County Property Accounting storage area at no cost or liability to Orange County.
