

RESOLUTION NO. 90-M-68

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF ADVISORY BOARD APPOINTEE TERMS DUE TO EXPIRE DECEMBER 31, 1990 FOR ALL ADVISORY BOARDS EXCEPT THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND THE BOARD OF ZONING ADJUSTMENT.

WHEREAS, numerous advisory board appointments among the various advisory boards expire on December 31, 1990; and

WHEREAS, with the change in structure of Orange County government and the election of new Orange County officials, numerous responsibilities have been immediately thrust upon the County Chairman and County Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County League of Women Voters are currently undertaking an independent study of the Orange County Advisory Board structure and it is anticipated that the findings and recommendations of that study will be presented to the County in or around April, 1991; and

WHEREAS, there currently exists insufficient time prior to December 31, 1990 to adequately prepare and make the necessary appointments to the more than seventy (70) advisory boards; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to review and take into consideration the findings and recommendations of the League of Women Voters Study prior to making the necessary advisory board appointments; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Orange County, Florida, believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Orange County to extend these terms due to expire on December 31, 1990 for all advisory board appointees except for Planning and Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning Adjustment appointees by six (6) months to allow time for rational and informed appointments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Every advisory board appointment except for the Planning and Zoning Commission and Board of Zoning

1 Adjustment in which the term is due to expire on December 31,
2 1990 is hereby granted an extension of the appointment term
3 for six (6) months so the term shall henceforth expire on
4 June 30, 1991.

5 Section 2. New appointments or reappointments to the
6 several advisory boards shall be made by the Board of County
7 Commissioners in accordance with the enabling legislation of
8 each particular advisory board prior to June 30, 1991 with
9 the effective date of such appointments being July 1, 1991.

10 Section 3. If the Board of County Commissioners
11 determines that a new appointment or reappointment on a
12 particular advisory board is warranted before the July 1,
13 1991 date set forth above, then the Board may grant an
14 earlier appointment with the specific effective date of the
15 appointment stated as part of the adoption motion. This
16 granting of an appointment with a specific effective date
17 shall cause the prior appointment to automatically terminate
18 upon the day prior to the specific effective date of new
19 appointment.

20 Section 4. It is the intent of the Board of County
21 Commissioners that the operation and function of the several
22 advisory boards shall remain unaffected by this Resolution
23 except as specifically set forth in Sections 1 through 3
24 above. Except as set forth above, this Resolution shall not
25 change or have an influence upon the enabling legislation,
26 powers, duties, and procedures of the several advisory boards.

27 Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective on the
28 date of its adoption.
