2 A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ORANGE COUNTY
3 SCHEDULE OF FEES AS TO CERTAIN FEES CHARGED
4 BY THE DATA SYSTEMS DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY
5 MEDICAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, ENGINEERING
6 DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
7 DEPARTMENT, FIRE DEPARTMENT, HEALTH
8 DEPARTMENT, PLANNING DEPARTMENT, PUBLIC
9 UTILITIES ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, PUBLIC
10 UTILITIES CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT, AND
11 ZONING DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
12 DATE.

13 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority
14 by law to enact and, from time to time, to revise fees
15 charged by the various departments of the Orange County
16 Government for various services rendered to the public; and

17 WHEREAS, Orange County can legally charge a fee for such
18 services that captures the reasonable cost associated with
19 administrative costs, and the County's costs of personal
20 services, operations, capital, and overhead to provide such
21 services; and

22 WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget conducted a
23 study in certain departments to determine reasonable costs,
24 and certain fees should be changed as a result of said study;
25 and

26 WHEREAS, there are cases in which the Board of County
27 Commissioners is empowered to levy fees for County services
28 but the amount of such fees is set by statute; and

29 WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget has included
30 supplementary fee enactments or revisions to the County's
31 comprehensive fee directory in the form and manner set forth
32 herein below; and

33 WHEREAS, the Office of Management and Budget has
34 recommended that these fees be approved by the Board of
35 County Commissioners effective May 1, 1991.

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

The Board of County Commissioners hereby revises certain
existing fees or establishes certain new fees, as the case
may be, and promulgates such revised or newly established

1 fees in the schedule of fees attached hereto and made a part
2 hereof by this reference.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other resolutions or
4 parts of resolutions in conflict herewith by establishing
5 earlier fees inconsistent with those established herein are
6 hereby repealed.

7 This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
