RESOLUTION NO. 91-M-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PERTAINING TO THE ORANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BOARD; AMENDING THE RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON JANUARY 15, 1975 TO PROVIDE FOR SEVEN MEMBERS AND TWO YEAR STAGGERED TERMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted a Resolution on January 15, 1975 creating a Community Development Board to consist of fifteen (15) citizens of Orange County appointed by the Board of County Commissioners for one (1) year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to amend that Resolution to provide for a total of seven (7) members, with one (1) member to be appointed from each of the County Commissioner districts upon recommendation of the district Commissioner and one (1) member to be appointed at large upon recommendation of the County Chairman, for staggered terms of two (2) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of the Resolution adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on January 15, 1975 is hereby amended as follows:

(a) Membership. FURTHER,--BE--IT--RESOLVED that--The Community Development Board will consist of fifteen--citizens--of Orange---County seven (7) members appointed---by---the---Board---of---County

Commissioners; one (1) member to be appointed from each of the County Commissioners districts upon recommendation of the district Commissioner and one (1) member to be appointed at large upon recommendation of the County Chairman. Each recommendation of an appointee shall take effect only if confirmed by vote of the Board of County Commissioners. If a recommendation fails to attain confirmation by the Board of County Commissioners, then a new recommendation shall be made by the same district Commissioner or by the County Chairman, as appropriate. The new recommendation shall likewise require confirmation by the Board of County Commissioners.

(b) Terms of Office. Following the initial staggering period set forth in the next sentence, the terms of office of members of the Community Development Board shall be for two years, however such appointments shall continue to be effective until their successors are chosen. As of the effective date of this section in 1991, all present appointments are terminated and new appointments shall be made and be effective from July 1, 1991 through the date indicated:

<u>At Large</u>	<u>June 30, 1993</u>

A member of the Community Development Board shall not serve more than two (2) consecutive full terms, unless this restriction is waived by a two-thirds vote of the members of the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
