RESOLUTION NO. 91-M-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PERTAINING TO THE ROAD CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVEN MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR TERMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, by motion on March 25, 1971, created the Road Construction Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners amended the March 25, 1971 motion by motion on January 17, 1980, increasing the number of members of the Road Construction Advisory Board to eleven (11); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners now desires to decrease the membership of the Road Construction Advisory Board to seven (7) and to provide for staggered terms of office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Members. The Road Construction Advisory Board shall consist of seven (7) members as follows: two (2) representatives of road construction firms, two (2) representatives of the home builders association, two (2) consulting engineers, and one (1) soils engineer.

SECTION 2. Terms. In order to achieve continuity through the staggering of terms of office which shall commence on July 1, 1991, four (4) members shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year and three (3) members shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years. All subsequent appointments shall be staggered for two (2) year terms.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon the date of passage.
